Your **analytic approach to visualisation** is required in the Project Delivery Team, where we support our clients by building meaningful visual models that are hosted on our bespoke platform. Your role will ensure we leverage the compositional aspects of our visual models, to best communicate client data and narratives. This role will be fulfilled by a someone with experience of client-facing consulting, **who is a skilled visual designer**, and has strong communications skills. As well as learning our own visual methodology, you will be further expanding your client handling and project management experience, with opportunities to grow in data handling and systems thinking.

We expect this role will be doing:

Collaborating closely with others in the delivery team to co-create visuals that are clear, aesthetically appealing, and convey meaningful content, by:

- Creating initial sketches (hand-drawn or digital) of client narratives, systems, and models for use in conversation externally with the client and internally with our team
- Working with clients directly via interviews and facilitated workshops in order to understand
 what they want to communicate, who the audience is, and what details are required to bring
 the composition to life
- Use visualisation techniques during in-person sense-making with clients, building intuitive models that can support thinking on complex topics
- Analysing client information (interview notes, documents and datasets) to extract insights for visual communication and understand how this data could be presented on our platform
- Creating rich pictures of client ecosystems, translating these from hand drawn sketches into detailed adobe illustrator files
- Working with our library of visual assets in Adobe Illustrator and adapting existing visual content for use in new projects

- Writing clear briefs and developing draft examples for our illustrators to produce more detailed versions for our interactive platform.
- Designing visuals suitable for our interactive platform that meaningfully reflect the client's reality – sometimes captured in tabular datasets – in pursuit of their change-based outcomes.
- Working within the constraints of project budgets, reporting on timelines around visual deliverables, and coordinating with other team members to ensure client expectations are met
